Current assignments are Flagship Program Leader for Vegetable Diversity and Improvement and Lead Scientist for Vegetable Genomics and Phenomics at WorldVeg and Adjunct Professor for Tropical Agriculture at the National Cheng Kung University in Tainan, Taiwan. The main research interests are to mobilize vegetable biodiversity for breeding of improved cultivars and the application of automatic phenotyping tools for research and breeding.
